## Information Sought

### Bank Robbery

On September 28, 2016, at approximately 2:03 pm, deputies from the Harford County Sheriff's Office, assigned to the Southern Precinct, responded to the Wells Fargo Bank in the 400 block of Constant Friendship Blvd, for the report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, deputies were informed that a black male suspect, implied he had a weapon, and fled the store with an undisclosed amount of cash. He fled on foot in the direction of Tollgate Road.

The suspect is described as a black male, 5'6"-5'8" with a slender build. He has a dark complexion, short hair, and facial hair.
